



VISION

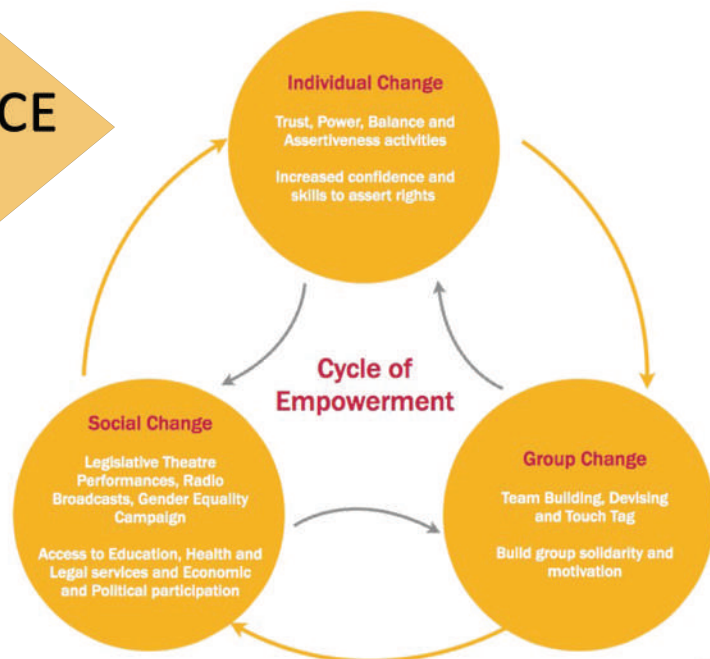
To see vulnerable and marginalised groups empowered with the knowledge, awareness and skills to positively transform their lives, and the lives of others, at local, national and international levels.

At Theatre for a Change, Participatory Learning emphasises learning through sharing and discovery, where participants are considered 'experts' in their own lives.

Learning is structured to enhance the potential for behaviour change using Knowledge, Attitudes and Skills (KAS).

THE GREATEST IMPACTS WERE SEEN AMONG THE MOST MARGINALISED GIRLS



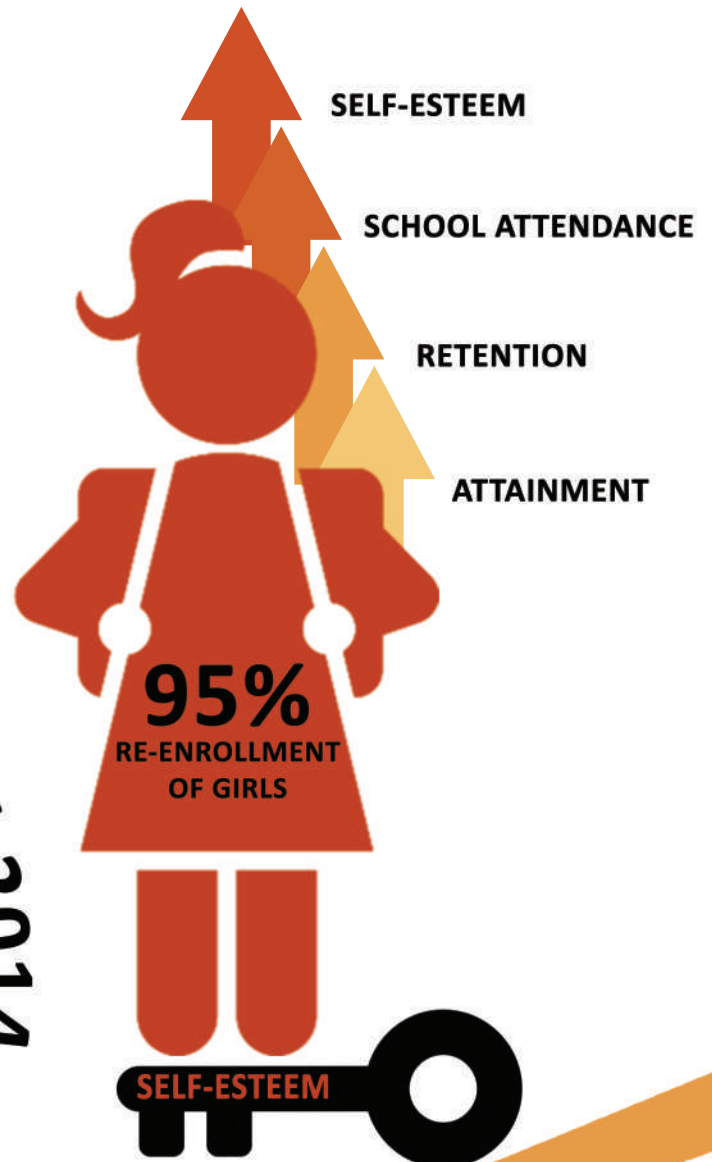
Girls have significantly improved their SRH after taking part in the project.

Tiphunzire! girls were less likely to be sexually active, married or to have been pregnant.



Girls who were in the programme for 3 years significantly improved their literacy
